Martin/Chris,

TfL only has one question regarding the Alliance Rail applications and it applies equally to the Section 17 and 18 applications..

You may be aware that several London Overground Class 378 units are stabled at Euston station overnight and we expect this requirement to remain in the future. The Alliance Rail Holdings consultation document notes in Section 4.6 that around half of the fleet of 17 units is likely to be stabled away from the Crewe depot overnight. Are you able to confirm whether some of these units will be stabled at Euston and, if so, can you confirm whether there is sufficient stabling capacity at Euston to accommodate these units alongside those of other operators including London Overground?
